Position Overview

The Mississauga Southwest Baseball Association (MSBA) is seeking an *Umpire Scheduling Coordinator* to support the efficient onboarding and scheduling of officials for our baseball games. Reporting to the Umpire-In-Chief, who is a member of the MSBA Board of Directors, this role is essential to the success of the Umpires program and its operations.

Key Responsibilities

The Umpire Scheduling Coordinator will:

- **Onboarding New Officials**: Facilitate the onboarding of new officials into the scheduling system and ensure proper set-up for the 2025 season.
- **Database Management**: Maintain the database of officials, ensuring all contact information is complete and accurate.
- **Game Scheduling**: Input and manage the master schedule of games and assign officials based on their certification levels.
- **Schedule Amendments**: Adjust assignments to accommodate changes such as official availability, inclement weather, or other factors.
- Payroll Support: Produce periodic game summaries for umpire payroll processing.
- **Communication**: Communicate expectations, needs, and schedule updates effectively with officials, coaches, convenors and others as required.
- Provide other support to the umpire program as required

Qualifications

The ideal candidate should have:

- Comfort and familiarity with online software. Experience with scheduling platforms is an asset.
- Availability to begin training with the online scheduling system as of March 1st, 2025.
- Real-time availability from approximately May 1st to September 30th to address time-sensitive scheduling matters.
- Strong communication skills to clearly convey expectations and address scheduling needs with officials.
- A general understanding of baseball rules and operations.
- Use of a cellular phone

Compensation

This is an honorarium-based position, with an annual honorarium of **\$4,500 CAD**. This honorarium will be paid in four installments from May-August.
